3D Printer Use Policy

The Library District owns several 3D printers that may be used for programming.

3D printers are used to make 3-dimensional objects in plastic using a digital file. The following guidelines should be employed when using 3D printers in any Maricopa County Library District programming.

3D printers may not be used to create objects that:

- Are prohibited by local, state, or federal law
- Are in violation of the library's code of conduct
- Are unsafe, harmful, dangerous, or which pose an immediate threat to the well-being of others, or are otherwise inappropriate for the Library environment
- Reproduce objects or materials that are subject to copyright, patent, or trademark protection
